Updates from the AMA

We've received some updates from the AMA regarding the work they're doing in Washington D.C., specifically related to "Section 349: EXEMPTION FOR LIMITED RECREATIONAL OPERATIONS OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT". Please see the summary below as provided by Chad Budreau, the AMA Interim Executive Director.

The AMA Government Relations team has been hard at work representing AMA in Washington, D.C. Here are some of the newest highlights to share with your club members:

- Section 349, EXEMPTION FOR LIMITED RECREATIONAL OPERATIONS OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT, will eventually replace Section 336.
- For the immediate future, AMA members are to fly as they always have under our programming.
- It might take months for Section 349 to be fully implemented. In the meantime, AMA and the FAA have created a team to ensure that our operations can be exempted under 349. We're meeting multiple times a week and things are looking promising. The goal is for AMA Headquarters to do the heavy lifting in implementing 349, so our clubs and members won't experience much during the transition.
- Section 349 gives AMA a more prominent role in shaping future regulations, allowing us to champion for hobbyists.
- The five-mile airport notification rings will be removed.
- Congress codified elements of our safety program into law including First Person View (doc 550).

The key point for us, at least for now, is that we are to fly as we always have under our programming. No changes just yet. If you're curious about Section 349, here's a link to the full details:


