
*Penguin Fly

Directions to Jim Porter's Home for December Meeting

- 1. At the intersection of Meredith Drive and 156th St, turn north on to 156th St.

Membership meeting minutes for November, submitted by John Faust

Nov 1st General Monthly Meeting

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm with 36 members present.

John Faust read the October meeting minutes and they were approved as read.

Denis Roy read the treasures report, he stated:

The detailed budget is shared with the club's board every month at the board meetings.

2016 Budget / Outlook:

The auction netted a total of \$2,062.19 for the club vs the \$750 in the budget.

• Donations from a widow of a modeler, and some club members, accounted for about \$1,200 of the \$2.062.19

The Harvest Huck netted \$589.36 for the club vs the \$250 in the budget.

The new lights at EPJ cost \$266.69 vs the requested \$600.

I have not received the bill for the kybos yet but expect that bill to be around \$812.

Based on the net from the auction, the net from the Harvest Huck, and the reduced cost of the new lights at EPJ the club should end 2016 up about \$2,500.

2017 Budget Assumptions:

- 125 members 110 full year adult members, 5 part year adult members, 10 youth members, 3 complimentary members
- The lease at both fields will be the same as 2016
- All 2017 routine expenses will be the same as 2016
- No Harvest Huck dollars as the Harvest Huck will not be held at EPJ in 2017.
- The net from the auction was increased to \$1,000 vs \$750
- Two indoor flies at \$125 each
- Mower Maintenance \$500 at both fields
- General Maintenance \$500 at both fields
- Solar Station Parts at West Field \$300 for new batteries

This results in a net of \$1,800 for 2017

Treasurers report was approved as read.

Ray Pick reported on the October auction and proposed ways to make more for the club. After some

discussion the decision was made to charge a \$5.00 entry fee and also charge a \$10.00 fee for any unsold auction item. (Clarification by President Porter: as to the auction, I believe that the \$10 fee was for anything that was sold outside of the auction, either before or after. In this way we collect something for those sales. Items not sold do not incur any fee.) One member also volunteered to look for an alternate venue to hold the auction that might be free of charge.

Jim Porter introduced a proposal to explore splitting the club as a club member had suggested this was needed and many members felt the same way. Porter also stated the board had voted unanimously to recommend not splitting the club. After a lengthy discussion a motion was made to take a vote concerning the proposal to explore splitting the club. The vote was 11 voted for splitting the club, 21 voted against splitting the club, and 4 members abstained. Then a motion was made not to bring up splitting the club for at least five years, the motion passed.

Several members discussed issues that brought about friction between the two fields and may help the two groups to get along better ie: publishing the board minutes, holding board meetings in front of the membership and sending out an agenda before each general membership meeting. The club decided to post board meeting minutes on the website and send out an agenda for the board meetings.

Meeting was adjourned about 8:30

Nov 9th Emergency meeting to address the Nov. 5 incident at EPJ.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm with 24 members present.

Both Tom V and Matt M gave their account of the incident. Several of the members' present disagreed with Matt's account of the midair. Jim Porter said that there were really two incidents involved, the midair and then the destruction of Tom's model. He also added that there had not been any attempt made by Matt to resolve the situation and asked the members what they thought should happen. John F made a motion that Matt not be allowed to fly until Tom had a flyable model again. The motion was seconded, voted on, and passed. Jim Porter said that he would make arrangements with Hobby Haven so that Matt could resolve the situation. Matt is to pay for a new 1/4 scale Fokker D-7 kit from balsa USA as well as four rolls of Solartex covering.

Several members asked the board to develop guidelines for removing a member from the club. Members will send suggestions to board members.

Meeting was adjourned about 8:00



Aircraft Model Storage Method by Jack Kamerick

Have you ever thought about how to store all those models you have collected? Here is how Modelaires Jack Kamerick solved the problem maximizing space and

keeping hanger rash to a minimum.

The set up simply consists of two lag hooks, 1/8 inch cable, two cable loop ends, two 1/8 inch cable crimps, one turn buckle and however many snap hooks you need. I used light weight piano wire (foamie control rod wire) to make the snap hook hangers and prop nut hooks. I also just used large loops of



twine to hang the bottom models. In all I don't think I have more than \$20 in the whole set up.





Escapade 30cc by Great Planes



The plane is an Escapade 30cc made by Great Planes. It is powered by a DLE 35cc engine. The control surfaces are powered by Futaba S3305 servos (high torque, metal gear) and the choke and throttle Futaba S3010 servos. I fly my fueled aircraft with a Futaba 14SG transmitter and the Escapade uses an 8 channel receiver.

The maiden flight was uneventful and it only required 3 clicks of right aileron to fly straight and level.

This is not a 3D plane by any means, but it is a good flying sport aircraft. It is solid and easy to fly.

If you want to enter the realm of gasoline powered models and can fly a 60 size sport plane, then this would be a great 1st gasser.




