On July 6th we hosted the Civil Air Patrol 2019 Encampment at West Field. This is the 4th time we have worked with this group of Cadets. We hosted the group in 2015, 2016, 2018, and again this year.



The Des Moines Modelaires maintains two high-quality, friendly flying locations in the Des Moines area. See below for address and map information:


