








SPEKTRUM TRANSMITTERS, a possible problem



I recently found that Spektrum recommends that you NOT have the SD card installed in your transmitter while flying. If, for some reason the card has a problem, it's possible for it to affect the transmitter while you are flying. If you are lucky it will first show up as a problem when you turn on the transmitter - a blank or dark screen. Unfortunately, this means that you cannot save any telemetry data after a flight because it's also recommended that you NOT insert OR remove the SD card while the transmitter is on. *Jim Porter*

In an exchange of emails from club members it seems the problem with SD cards with DX series transmitters may be related to large or corrupt SD cards. (summary by editor)

A Little Good News about the 400' Altitude 'Limit'

The following was sent to all AMA Leader Members.

AMA and the FAA are still discussing options regarding a permanent blanket waiver to operate above 400 feet in Class G airspace. Until this waiver is finalized, continue to operate within AMA safety programming. AMA HQ will update our members when more information is available.



My comments:

AMA safety programming does NOT include an altitude limitation.

As a point of information, **Class G** is completely uncontrolled airspace, and both of the Des Moines Modelaires fields are in class G airspace. **Jim Porter**

The Des Moines Modelaires maintains two high-quality, friendly flying locations in the Des Moines area. See below for address and map information:


