The Des Moines Modelaires - General Membership Meeting Minutes

August 4, 2015

The meeting was held at the club's West Field in Grimes Iowa. The meeting was called to order by club President Alan Annear at 7:00pm. There were 20 members present.

The club Secretary, Keith Page, presented the minutes from the July general meeting. The minutes were approved and accepted.

The club President, Alan Annear, presented a short summary of the Treasurers report in Denis Roy's' absence. The Treasurers report was approved and accepted.

Old Business:

Alan discussed the club's hosting of the Civil Air Patrol Cadets (CAP), he stated that 34 CAP members had attended, and that Dave Beecher and Denis Roy helped with buddy box flying for 8 to 12 of the CAP members. He said the CAP leaders were so impressed by the demo flights and Buddy Box flying that they would like to repeat the event next year.

Alan then reported that he, Keith Page, Dar Chapman, and Tim Nissen assisted a small church youth group with an introduction to our hobby and Buddy Box flying at EPJ on July 29th.

Tim Nissen reported that the City of Elkhart demonstration was well attended both by townspeople and our members and was well appreciated by the townspeople.

New Business:

Alan reported that Mike Moore had gotten injured when one of the plastic chairs at EPJ collapsed when he sat in it. Alan is forwarding a report to the AMA insurance department in case of a potential claim is submitted.

Alan stated that Ms. Tracy Codel of a Church Ladies Adventure group would like to fly RC planes and would like to scheduled some time with him, likely on August 15thduring our Model Aviation Day event but he will otherwise coordinate a date with them.

Alan then asked for a volunteer to fill an open Board of Directors position. Two members volunteered with the position going to John Faust.

Alan then presented to the membership the issue of landing fees versus membership fees and how they apply to the operations the club. He stated we need to operate the club in a positive cash flow manner. Denis Roy's presentation of several 2016 budget options was then discussed with the membership present. The potential options presented were:

- 1. Membership dues \$75, and a \$10.00 landing fee for each "fun fly" resulting in a \$400 profit
- 2. Membership dues \$85, and no landing fees for "fun fly" events resulting in a \$690 profit
- 3. Membership dues \$90, and no landing fees for "fun fly" events resulting in a \$1,335 profit
- 4. Membership dues \$100.00, and no landing fees for "fun fly" events resulting in a \$2,425.00 profit

The options were then voted on:

#1 received 1 vote.

#2 received 1 vote.

#3 received 1 vote.

#4 received 15 votes.

There was also 1 vote to have landing fees and to increase the dues to \$90.

There was also 1 vote to have landing fees sufficient enough to pay for lunch and to increase the dues to \$100.

Following the voting, a motioned was made and seconded, and vote passed to accept the option of "no fun fly landing fees, and increasing the 2016 annual membership dues to \$100.00.

Alan then clarified that the discussion of landing fees has always applied our club fun flys, and that they are still required for any AMA sanctioned events or events largely attended by more than our club members.

He announced that he will be continuing the "coffee socials" on the second Saturday of each month. Coffee will be ready at 10:00am.

He then reminded everyone:

August 15th is National Model Aviation Day at West Field – hosted by Alan Annear

We are asking for a \$5.00 donation for the Wounded Warrior Project and lunch will be available for \$5. All profits will be donated to the Wounded Warrior Project.

August 29th Heli Fun Fly at EPJ - hosted by Matt Coleman

September 5th Sailplane Fun Fly at West Field - hosted by Dave Beecher

The last Monday Night Training event will be on Aug 31st.

The next general membership meeting will be on September 1st at 7:00pm at EPJ.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 PM.
