Tyler announced that our club has received a check for \$1,000.00 from the AMA under our TAG program to help defray expenses for a 75th Anniversary (of both our club and the AMA) flying and public relations event this summer. A teacher from Wallace Elementary School in Johnston has asked our club to hold 20 minutes instruction sessions at their school on May 26th. This would be in support of the flight or aviation program. Craig Davidson is establishing an indoor flying program, in which the cost would be \$200.00 per session or meet, regardless of how many flyers might meet at any one time, and asked about affiliating with our club to gain insurance coverage and other AMA benefits. The directors declined to affiliate with this group, citing management and overview shortages or difficulties. Tyler presented a blueprint for building the new solar charging station at Westfield. Discussion included some improvements and suggestions and was accepted as a viable building project. The directors, following discussion, voted to reserve EPJ field on Thursday nights from 5:00 PM until dark, specifically for the TAG program. Members are invited to attend and help, but flying will be reserved to students and instructors. The TAG program will run from June 2 until Sep 1. The addition of Petro-Mat to the second runway at Westfield was estimated to run about \$2,000.00, using 3 rolls of petromat. Building a new runway running NE to SW, intersecting at the south end of the current runway was also discussed and approved.

General meeting 7:30 pm.

The subjects of the Director's Meeting were presented to the membership without exception. The membership voted to approved \$2000.00 for the new petro-mat runway for Westfield, as well as to fit the new runway at EPJ. Jim Lewis presented his recommendations for new shirts and hats for members, and asked for members that wanted these items to sign up through him. A mowing list for EPJ was passed around for people to sign up for that duty. It was also mentioned that members that might want to become involved with the indoor flying program of Craig Davidson can obtain more information at Hobby Haven. Tyler asked volunteers to help build the solar charging station to contact him. Ed Niles presented information and examples of switches or cutouts for electric models. Dan Hanson presented that Cutty Sark (the campground) has asked for a flying demonstration July 9 with a rain date of Jul 10.

Meeting adjured at 8:30 PM.
